Glossary

Accession Countries: Countries that joined the European Union (EU) between April 2001 and March 2011, namely Bulgaria; Cyprus; Czech Republic; Estonia; Hungary; Latvia; Lithuania; Malta; Poland; Romania; Slovakia; Slovenia

Average Persons Per Household: Total number of residents living in households in an area divided by the number of households in that area.

Average Rooms Per Household: Total number of rooms in households in an area divided by the number of households in that area.

Census Day: Census day was Sunday 27 March 2011.

Central Heating: A household's accommodation is classified as having central heating if it is present in some or all rooms (whether used or not).

Communal Establishment: An establishment providing managed residential accommodation. "Managed" means full-time or part-time supervision of the accommodation. This includes sheltered accommodation units, hotels, guest houses, B&Bs, inns/pubs and all accommodation provided solely for students (during term-time) and nurses.

Dependent Child: A person aged 0-15 in a household (whether or not in a family) or aged 16-18 in full-time education and living in a family with his or her parent(s). It does not include any children who have a spouse, partner or child living in the household.

Distance Travelled To Work: Distance in kilometres between a person's residential postcode and their workplace postcode, measured in a straight line.

Dwelling: A self-contained unit of accommodation, which may contain one or more households.

Economically Active: People who in the week before the census were in employment as an employee or self-employed, not in employment but seeking work and ready to start work within two weeks, or not in employment but waiting to start a job already obtained and available.

Economically Inactive: People who in the week before the census were not in employment but did not meet the criteria to be classified as 'Unemployed'. This includes those looking for work but not available to start work within two weeks, and those not looking for work, or unable to work - for example retired, looking after home / family.

Employed: A person who in the week before the census carried out at least one hour's paid work as an employee or self-employed. This includes casual or temporary work, government sponsored training schemes, paid / unpaid work for own / family business, being away from work ill, maternity leave, on holiday or temporarily laid off.

General Health: A person's self-assessment of their general state of health. This is not based on a person's health over any specified period of time.

Household: Either one person living alone, or a group of people (not necessarily related) living at the same address who share cooking facilities and share a living room, sitting room or dining area. A household must contain at least one person whose place of usual residence is at the address.

Household Space: The accommodation occupied by an individual household or, if unoccupied, available for an individual household.

Lone Parent Household: Comprises a father or mother with his or her child(ren) where the parent does not have a spouse, same-sex civil partner or partner in the household and the child(ren) do not have a spouse, same-sex civil partner or child in the household.

Long-Term Health Problem: Problem or disability that limits day-to-day activities and has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months. This includes problems related to old age.

Long-Term Unemployed: A person who at the time of the 2011 Census was unemployed and the year they last worked was 2009 or earlier.

Method Of Travel To Work: The method used for the longest part, by distance, of the usual journey to work.

Resident: Refers to a usual resident which is anyone who, on census day, was in the UK and had stayed or intended to stay in the UK for a period of 12 months or more, or had a permanent UK address and was outside the UK and intended to be outside the UK for less than 12 months.

Qualification, Highest Level: The highest level of qualification attained by residents based on the following equivalencies:

Level 1: 1-4 O Levels/CSEs/GCSEs (any grades); Entry Level; Foundation Diploma; NVQ level 1; Foundation GNVQ, Basic/Essential Skills

Level 2: 5+ O Levels (passes)/CSEs (Grade 1)/GCSEs (Grades A*-C); School Certificate; 1 A Level/2-3 AS Levels/VCEs; Intermediate/Higher Diploma; NVQ Level 2;

Intermediate GNVQ; City & Guilds Craft; BTEC First/General Diploma; RSA Diploma

Level 3: 2+ A Levels/VCEs; 4+ AS Levels; Higher School Certificate; Progression/Advanced Diploma; NVQ level 3; Advanced GNVQ; City & Guilds Advanced Craft;

ONC: OND: BTEC National; RSA Advanced Diploma





Unemployed: Person not in employment, available to start work in the next two weeks, and either looking for work in the last four weeks or waiting to start a new job.


Resident Population


Age Structure








Lone Parent Households With Lone Parent Aged 16-74






County Of Birth


Length Of Residence In The United Kingdom






Limitations of Long-Term Health Problem or Disability








Main Language / Proficiency Status










Accommodation Type






